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BRIEF ADMINISTRATION GUIDE

Critical Note: there are minor variations between the ANMF and Waikato DHB best practice within this drug guideline – see yellow shaded text

Indications:

Prevention of necrotising enterocolitis in preterm infants < 32 weeks gestation or
 1500 g birth weight

Note: Not to be given if NBM for medical/surgical reasons or Lactobacillus sepsis

Route: Oral

- Supplied as Infloran 250mg capsule
 - Each capsule contains Lactobacillus acidophilus 10⁹ CFU and Bifidobacterium bifidum 10⁹ CFU
 - o Infloran is an unapproved medicine in NZ, available under Section 29

Dose:

• 250mg (one capsule) daily, until 36 weeks corrected gestation or discharge

Preparation and administration

- Open one capsule and mix the contents with 1 mL of milk, formula or sterile water
- Administer immediately

Note: for babies on small amounts of milk feeds Infloran can be divided between two feeds.

Storage and Stability

- Once opened the Infloran capsule should be discarded within 2 hours
- Infloran must be kept in the fridge (between 2°C and 8°C)

Competency for administration

This procedure is carried out by, or under, the direct supervision of a registered nurse/registered midwife who holds current Waikato DHB Generic Medicine Management.
